Inaugural speech by Prof. K. S. James

Prof. K. S. James in his inaugural speech highlighted that, An increasing proportion of the population that is of working age provides an opportunity to reap a "demographic dividend," through increase in the numbers of potential workers and an accelerated accumulation of capital due to reduced spending on dependents. This matter is of great

significant for the country's income and growth prospects. India's demographic has a bulge in the centre, a concentration of people in the age group that constitutes nations potential workforce, its storehouse of talent, energy and scalable performance shall not turn into a nightmare.

Details of Technical sessions

There were six technical sessions held in tune with the theme of the conference.

The *first* technical session on **Dimensions of Demography and Rural and Urban Disparity, Dr. Jayakumar Shetty, Associate Professor,** *SDM College Ujire* chaired the session, and **Dr. Ramesh Salian** was the moderator of the session. 13 papers were presented in this session.

The *second* technical session on **Social Security & Composition Demography**, *Dr. Goapalappa*, Faculty, Department of Economics, Mysore University was the chairperson, *Mr. Ramesh Reddy*, *University college of Arts, Tumkur* was the moderator of the session. Total of 11 papers were presented in this session.

The *third* technical session on **Challenges and Opportunities**, *Dr. Radhakrishna Bhat M, Associate Professor Pompei College*, *Aikala*, *DK* was the chairperson and *Mr. Umesh*, *University college of Arts*, *Tumkur* was the moderator of the session. A total 7 papers were presented in this session.

About 150 delegates participated in the conference.
