

Inaugural speech by Prof. S Bisaliah

In his key note address *Prof. Bislliah* pointed out that "Urbanization is a black spot in the country, as it generates more slums. There is need for considering the principles of Abdul Kalam and Gunnar Myrdal in the present scenario. Further poverty has worsened and welfare programmes have failed after globalization in the name of urbanization".
